

World Handicap System – Guidance for Individual Stroke play Competitions

Competition Entry – Individual Stroke play formats

You must have booked a tee time using the ClubV1 app, and you must enter the competition before you start using the HDID App or PSI in the spike bar, if available.

Maximum Handicap

Competitions are open to all members however currently there will be a maximum Handicap Index applied of 28 for the competition result. Your handicap index calculation at the end of the round will be based upon your actual Handicap Index and your WHS record will be updated accordingly.

Score Card

This applies to Stroke play: Medal, Stableford and Bogey formats

Minimum information to be included are: Competition Name, Date, Name of Player, Handicap Index (enter left of the handicap box) and Course Handicap for the tees being played (enter in the handicap box) along with the gross score for each hole. Enter a score of 0 [zero] for any hole that is not completed.

At the end of the round the card should be signed by the marker and the player, but during the Covid-19 restrictions, only the player's signature is required, but the score should be validated with another player.

Score submission

The score must first be entered electronically via either the 'Score-Entry' tab of the HDID App before you leave the club or via the PSI terminal in the Spike Bar.

The card must then be placed in the box in the spike bar or lounge. Currently the deadline time for entering scores will be sunset.

If a card is not submitted on the day, then the score will be withdrawn from the competition. It is now mandatory that scores / cards are submitted and penalties can be applied for repeated non-submission.
