BOBBY LOCKE (South Africa)

Open Champion, 1950

At the age of 14, won South African Boys' Championship. Won the Open Championship 1949, after a tie with Harry Bradshaw. Won Amateur Open Championship of South Africa several times, and numerous major tournaments all over the world. In 1948 played in the United States tournaments and won £6,500 in prize money. Acknowledged to be one of the finest golfers the world has ever known.

ALF PADGHAM

Professional at Sundridge Park, which position he has held for many years. Prior to this he served at Royal Ashdown Forest in a similar capacity. Won Open Championship 1936, Sussex Professional Championship 1933, Kent Professional Championship 1938, and the following tournaments: 'Daily Mail' 1936, 1946; 'News Chronicle' 1939; 'News of the World' 1931, 1935; 'Silver King' 1936, 1939, 1947; 'Dunlop-Southport' 1934, 1936.
