

Polite Reminder

Thank you to all members for adhering to the procedures put in place by the Board of Directors for either arriving to play golf and using the clubhouse after golf. It is essential that the club operates under the Government Guidance and to maintain social distancing measures.

Arrival to Play:

It has been noted that some members do come to the club in advance of the 30 minute arrival time and as a general reminder to all the following procedure needs to be adhered to ensuring that social distancing measures are maintained:

1. Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time; should you arrive earlier please do not enter Zone 3 (practice area) until the marshal is happy for you to do so. Zone 3 allows for 10 minutes in the nets and/or on the chipping area. (Maximum of one group at a time).
2. From Zone 3 move to Zone 2 and use the putting green for approximately 10 minutes prior to moving down to Zone 1.
3. Move down to Zone 1 once the group ahead has cleared the 1st tee and the marshal has advised you to do so.

Clubhouse:

Since re-opening on Wednesday, 8th July 2020 it has been noted that some members are not adhering to the following procedures ensuring that social distancing measures are maintained:

1. The seating inside and outside of the clubhouse has been designed to conform to social distancing – it is a maximum of 4 to a table and should [ideally] only be for those players you have played with. Please do not move chairs to make larger groups.
2. At times when the club is not busy it will be permitted to stay more than the 20 minutes and have more than one drink; but please be sensible and considerate to other members and not overstay unduly and thus create a gathering on the terrace or around the lounge tables.
3. At the recent Captain's Prize the weather turned wet in the afternoon and reviewing the CCTV cameras it clearly showed that social distancing could not safely be maintained. If you are here and the weather changes you may move inside to an available table but if these are taken then you will need to finish your drink and leave for home.
